Discounts & Accommodations and Meals

The Notre Dame Adult Tennis Camp is expected to sell out quickly, and is limited to the first 60 adults registering and submitting all charges due. Registration is limited to persons 18 years and over.

If overnight accommodations are needed, campers have two options. St. Edwards Hall, located on the Notre Dame campus, offers a clean, safe, dorm environment for \$30 per room, per night. St. Eds is not air-conditioned, so bringing a portable fan would be advisable. Rooms will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis until dorm capacity is reached. The Jamison Inn, located within walking distance to the ND tennis courts, is a lovely setting offering accommodations. Breakfast is included each morning. We have arranged a special rate for campers of \$70.00 per night. Room reservations for tennis campers must be made by May 27, 2005. Campers are responsible to reserve and pay for their own lodging. When calling to reserve a room, be sure to mention that you are with the Notre Dame Monogram Tennis Camp.
