What Every Camper Should Know

Camp Dates: ⊇ Residential “Elite” Camp; July 11-15, 2001
 ⊇ Residential “Advanced” Camp; July 25-29, 2001

Registration: ⊇ Tent in D6 parking lot
 9 Noon - 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 11
 9 Noon - 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 25

Directions: ⊇ Notre Dame is located on the outskirts of South Bend, Indiana, approximately 90 miles east of Chicago on the Indiana Toll Road, Exit 77
 ⊇ Proceed through Exit 77 toll plaza, turn right onto U.S. 33/Business 31 South at traffic light. Λ
 ⊇ Follow 33/31 south through two sets of traffic lights.
 ⊇ Turn east (left) onto Dorr Road immediately after the WNDU TV/Radio station sign. This drive pulls into the D6 parking lot. Registration will occur under the large tent in the D6 parking lot.

Departure: ⊇ Departure dates and times:
 9 11:30 am Sunday, July 15
 9 11:30 am Sunday, July 29
 ⊇ Park in the **D6** parking lot and meet campers in front of dormitory.

Early Arrivals/
Late Departures: ⊇ Early arrivals and late departures are discouraged. If a camper must arrive early or stay late, it is his responsibility to find local housing and transportation. The Morris Inn is an on-campus hotel and can be reached at (219) 631-2000.

Non-Boarders: ⊇ Non-Boarders should register with all other campers.
Housing: ⊇ The Notre Dame Boys Soccer Camp will be residing in an Undergraduate Residence Hall on the Notre Dame campus.
 ⊇ Please note that maintenance takes place in the dorms throughout the summer months. Thank you for your patience and

understanding.

Health & Safety:

- ⊇ A University athletic trainer will be on duty each day during hours of scheduled camp activity.
- ⊇ University Health Services facilities or the local hospital will be available 24 hrs.
- ⊇ University Security stations a monitor in each residence hall utilized by the summer sports camps between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- ⊇ All meals are prepared under the direction of the University dietician and served in the University's North Dining Hall.
- ⊇ Drugs, alcoholic beverages and cigarettes are strictly forbidden and constitute, along with general misconduct, grounds for immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.
- ⊇ Any damage to the residence halls will be billed to the parents of the campers who have been the cause of the damage or to the parents of the campers who are assigned to the particular room where the damage has occurred.

Cancellations:

- ⊇ If you must cancel, please do so early so that we can notify those on the waiting list.
- ⊇ If you cancel, and do so **prior to 2 weeks before** the start of camp, you will receive a refund less a **\$50.00** per session administrative fee. Otherwise, you will receive a refund less a **\$100.00** per session administrative fee.
- ⊇ **No refunds will be issued for any reason once a camp session has commenced!**

First Meal:

- ⊇ Please note that the first camp meal will be dinner on the first day of camp.

Last Meal:

- ⊇ Please note that the last camp meal will be breakfast on the last day of camp.

Camp Ball:

- ⊇ Each camper is required to supply his/her own soccer ball during camp. ⊇ An Adidas "Notre Dame" soccer ball will be available for \$35.00 (**no credit cards accepted**) at registration.
- ⊇ Please check the soccer ball box on the Adidas Ball Request Form on the following page and return it **at least 4 weeks** before the camp starts.

Airport Transportation: ⊇ Campers arriving to South Bend via plane, train or bus are responsible for finding their own transportation from the Michiana Regional Airport to the Notre Dame campus.

⊇ The following companies provide service from the airport to campus. The estimated cost is approximately \$10.00 each way.

* Campers are asked to wear black shorts and white soccer socks along with the camp shirts provided as the "uniform" for the week. One pair of black **adidas** shorts and 2 camp t-shirts are provided as part of the registration fee. Laundry machines are available on campus for those in need of those facilities.

Note: In the past, each camper was furnished with fresh bed linens and towels upon arrival, **however, this is no longer the case** and each camper is now responsible for bringing those items. Additionally, the residence hall is not air-conditioned. We strongly recommend that campers bring **small, portable fans** !
