QUICK HITTERS

> Mount St. Mary's opens its 44th season in program history at No. 6 Notre Dame. The Mount defeated Notre Dame by a 57-44 margin in the only previous meeting between the two teams back in 1981.

> Maria Marchesano was named the Mount's new head coach on May 1, coming over after a season as an associate head coach at IUPUI. Marchesano has five seasons combined of head coaching experience at Urbana University and Walsh University.

> The Mountaineers are coming off a 12-18 overall record and 10-8 mark in NEC play in 2016-17. They made an NEC playoff appearance for the sixth straight season, but fell in the quarterfinals at Bryant.

> The Mount returns nine of 13 players and 57.7% of its scoring from last year's squad.

MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

2016-17 SEASON RECAP

>>> The Mountaineers capped off the 2016-17 season at 12-18 overall as they reached the NEC playoffs for the sixth straight season.

>>> After opening conference play with a 3-6 mark, the Mountaineers won seven of their final nine games to finish the season at 10-8 in league play and secure the No. 5 seed.

>>> Caroline Hummell and Alexis Carter ranked top-two on the squad in both scoring and rebounding during the regular season. Hummell led the team in scoring (10.3) and Carter ranked first in rebounding (6.8). The duo combined for six double-doubles and 31 double-digit scoring performances.

INSIDE THE SERIES

>>> The Mount and Notre Dame are set to meet for just the second time in series history on Saturday.

>>> Mount St. Mary's won the lone matchup between the two teams, a 57-44 victory back in 1981 at the Penn Holiday Tournament.

MARCHESANO TAKES OVER THE HELM

>>> On May 1, Mount St. Mary's introduced Maria Marchesano as the sixth head coach in Mount women's basketball program history.

>>> Marchesano came to the Mount following a one-year stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season.

>>> Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University in North Canton, Ohio. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure at the helm.

KEY RETURNEES

>>> The Mount returns nine of 13 players and 57.7% of its scoring from last year's squad. Three starters from last year return in sophomore Ashlee White and seniors Katrice Dickson and Caroline Hummell.

>>> Hummell led the squad with 10.3 points per game and ranked second in rebounding with 5.2 per game. Dickson and White ranked fourth in fifth on the squad in scoring, respectively, and White topped the team in assists.

KEY LOSSES

>>> Mount St. Mary's lost two of its top-three scorers and rebounders from last year's team in Alexis Carter and Mikal Johnson

>>> Carter was a two-time All-NEC selection who led the Mount in rebounding and ranked second in scoring a season ago.

>>> Johnson transferred to the Mount as a grad student, and ranked third in both scoring and rebounding while topping the squad in three pointers in her lone season at the Mount.

TEAM CAPTAINS

>>> Head Coach Maria Marchesano named seniors Katrice Dickson and Caroline Hummell, junior Juliette Lawless and sophomore Kayla Agentowicz team captains prior to the start of the season.

>>> The quartet combined to play in 107 games last year for the Mountaineers.

FRESH FACES

>>> The Mount brought in six new freshmen to help bolster this year's squad: Bridget Birkhead (Doylestown, Pa.), Rebecca Lee (Severn, Md.), Hunter Rowson (Upper Marlboro, Md.), Jatarrikah Settle (Odenton, Md.), Daly Sullivan (South Bend, Ind.) and Aryna Taylor (Ashland, Va.).

>>> The recruiting class was ranked among the top-67 in the nation by BlueStar report and the No. 1 class in the Northeast Conference by The Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.

>>> Guard Daly Sullivan was ranked the 77th best recruit in the country by Prospects Nation, 154th by BlueStar Report and 190th by The Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.

NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

>>> Mount St. Mary's will challenge itself in non-conference play with a pair of matchups against top-25 competition.

>>> In addition to their matchup at No. 6 Notre Dame, the Mountaineers will also take on No. 15 Maryland in early December.

COACHES CONNECTION

>>> Assistant Coaches Ciara Geiger and Kelsey Funderburgh each have a connection to Head Coach Maria Marchesano prior to Mount St. Mary's.

>>> Geiger was a player under Marchesano at Urbana University, and went on to coach alongside Marchesano at Walsh University during the 2015-16 season.

>>> Funderburgh played for Marchesano at Walsh University for three seasons from 2013-16.

NEC PRESEASON POLL

>>> The Mount was picked to finish eighth in the Northeast Conference Coaches Poll for the second straight season.

>>> Last year, the Mountaineers outperformed their preseason ranking and finished as the No. 5 seed in the league.

SHARP SHOOTING

>>> The Mount ranked fourth in the Northeast Conference in both free throw percentage (.714) and three-point percentage (.309) a season ago.

NORTHEAST CONFERENCE AWARDS

>>> Three Mountaineers were recognized with 2016-17 conference honors as Alexis Carter was named All-NEC Second Team, Caroline Hummell earned All-NEC Third Team honors and Ashlee White was selected to the NEC All-Rookie Team.

>>> Carter led the Mount with 11.9 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.7 steals per contest in conference games. On the season, Carter ranked fifth in the league in three-point percentage (.360) and 10th in rebounding (6.8 rpg).

>>> Hummell led the Mountaineers in scoring with 10.3 points per game to go along with 5.2 rebounds while shooting 41.3 percent from the floor. Hummell ranked seventh in the NEC with a 78.8 percent mark from the free throw line, and also placed among the top-20 in the conference in scoring, field goal percentage, blocked shots and offensive rebounds.

>>> White's emergence as the starting point guard four games into conference play helped the Mountaineers turn their season around as they posted eight of their 12 wins with the rookie at the point. White led the squad in assists per game (1.7) and field goal percentage (.424), and registered double-digit points in six of the final nine games of the season.

HOME SWEET HOME

>>> The Mount owns a 254-140 all-time record at Knott Arena, including a 94-60 mark in Northeast Conference games.

>>> The Mountaineers have registered double-digit wins at home in 11 different seasons.

MARIA MARCHESANO BIO

Maria Marchesano was named the sixth head coach in Mount St. Mary's women's basketball history on May 1, 2017.

Marchesano came to the Mount following a stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season. During the campaign, the Jags collected seven wins versus RPI top-100 teams and earned their highest RPI ranking in program history (53). Marchesano coached three All-Summit League honorees and one Academic All-Summit League member during her season with the Jags.

Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University in North Canton, Ohio. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure at the helm.

In her final season at Walsh, she guided the Cavaliers to a 20-9 overall record and 16-6 mark in GLIAC play, as they earned home-court advantage for the first time ever in the conference tournament. During the regular season, the Cavaliers registered an upset-victory over third-ranked Ashland University, which was the highest-ranked opponent Walsh had ever defeated as a Division II program.

Marchesano got her first experience as a head coach at Urbana University in Urbana, Ohio midway through the 2011-12 season. She inherited a 2-8 team in January, before turning the season around, guiding the Knights to a 12-7 record after taking over the helm, which included an eight-game winning streak at home. The team qualified for the D-II Ohio Independent Championships, and Marchesano was named the D-II Independent Coach of the Year. The following season, Marchesano led the Knights to a G-MAC Conference Tournament Championship.

Before her time at Urbana, Marchesano served as an assistant coach for both the women's basketball and softball programs at Manchester College in North Manchester, Indiana from 2010-12.

During her collegiate career, Marchesano was a four-year letter winner at Butler University in women's basketball, and also played one season on the softball team. The Fort Wayne, Indiana native was named the Butler Freshman Female Athlete of the Year, earned Horizon League All-Newcomer Team honors, and was a recipient of the Butler Team Community Service Award. Marchesano finished her career as the second-best three-point shooter in program history. Following her collegiate career, she went on to sign three professional basketball contracts and five professional softball contracts in the Italian Federation.
